Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 on Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs)

This Regulation aims to protect human health and the environment by restricting or eliminating the production, placing on the market and use of Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs), in line with the Stockholm Convention.

1 Compliance statement

Based on the information available from our suppliers and internal processes, we confirm that:

- The products supplied by **Bossard Group** are **not intentionally manufactured using substances listed in Annex I** of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021.
- Therefore, such substances are **not expected to be present** in our products at the time of delivery.

2 Limitations

Please note that:

- Trace levels of certain substances may occur unintentionally (e.g. environmental contamination or impurities), which cannot be fully excluded.
- Bossard does not carry out systematic analytical testing of all supplied products for POPs substances unless specifically agreed.
- Therefore, absolute absence of these substances cannot be guaranteed under all circumstances.

3 Regulatory update management

Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 is **regularly amended**, in particular with:

- the addition of new substances,
- the tightening of concentration limits,
- and the removal of exemptions.

Bossard monitors regulatory developments and updates its internal processes and communications accordingly.
