Dear Patients and Carers

Critical cladding remediation works will commence at Calvary Mater Newcastle on Monday, 30 March 2026.

Scaffolding and hoarding have already been erected at the Platt Street end of the South Block in preparation for these works.

While this work is being carried out, we are introducing extra controls to maintain your safety. If you are at higher risk, such as being immunocompromised, it is recommended and encouraged that you wear a mask when entering the hospital via the Platt Street entrance.



Your treating team will have masks available prior to your appointment, or you can collect a mask from the Surgical Outpatient Services building located next to the P1 Platt Street car park before entering the hospital.

If you want to avoid the construction area, you may consider using the P2 Edith Street Car Park as an alternative entry point.
