

Attendee conduct

In consideration of others, attendees are requested to:

- Arrive early to begin on time at 10am.
- Bring a pen and writing paper if you would like to take notes.
- Abstain from alcohol for the duration of the programme (6 weeks).
- Be free from the influence of alcohol and other drugs, every session.
- Respect fellow attendees, presenters and facilitators at all times.
- Make a commitment to attend for six weeks. Ring 4014 4796 and let us know if you are unable to attend a session, or if you decide to withdraw from the programme.

Lifestyle is about:

Incorporating alternate healthy life choices to support a balanced and happy, alcohol free lifestyle.

Lifestyle is:

A supportive educational programme providing information about the impact of alcohol on your life. Lifestyle will assist with the skills to remain abstinent from alcohol.

Lifestyle welcomes:

All adults who are abstaining from alcohol.

Lifestyle topics include:

- relapse prevention
- nutrition
- relaxation
- stress management
- sleep strategies
- pharmacotherapy (medication) options
- goal setting and planning
- the physiology and psychology of alcohol abuse and dependence
- additional support groups and networking

Lifestyle has been:

Provided and endorsed by professionally trained clinicians and generous volunteers for over 20 years.

Lifestyle is not group therapy. Enquiries for individual counselling and group therapy can be made by ringing the Alcohol and Drug Unit on 4014 4796.

Criteria for attendance

- A desire to make the lifestyle changes as necessary to support a goal of abstinence from drinking alcohol.
- Abstinence from alcohol for the duration of the programme and consent to random breath testing if required.
- An assessment by a member of the Alcohol and Drug Unit or a recent referral from Lakeview Detoxification Centre or similar programme.

What to do next

Call the Alcohol and Drug Unit at Calvary Mater Newcastle on 4014 4796 and make an appointment for an assessment with an Alcohol and Drug Counsellor. The Lifestyle programme will be discussed with you and a booking made if appropriate.
