



Day Procedure Suite

Welcome.

We aim to make your visit to Calvary North Adelaide as comfortable as possible.

On the day of your Procedure, make sure you have all of the relevant cards and paperwork you will require for your hospital admission.

Please check in at the Reception on Level 1 Day Surgery. We estimate you will be with us for 3–4 hours, and we will call your escort to pick you up 30 minutes before your discharge.

Once you arrive your admission process will be completed. You'll be made to feel comfortable here with warm blankets and televisions for your entertainment. Bathroom facilities are also available. Your belongings will remain with you until surgery time and will then be securely locked away. We do however recommend that all jewelry or small valuables are left at home or with your escort.

Your admitting Doctor will set the fasting times, admission time and theatre list scheduling, so you may be waiting an extended time depending on your place on the list. If you have any questions or concerns please speak to the nursing staff.


Once your surgery is completed and you have recovered, you will be brought to the discharge area of the unit. Here you will be offered a light snack and have your discharge information explained. **The nursing staff will call your escort to advise them of your collection time.**

Access to this car park is via the laneway from Ward Street (next to the Mary Potter Hospice) that runs down the side of the hospital (please refer to the map). **When they arrive they will need to come up to Level 1, Day Procedure Suite and advise the reception staff of their arrival.**

Calvary North Adelaide Hospital is open 6am–10pm. The rear door near Hudsons Café is open 6.15am–6.15pm.

If you are feeling unwell, experiencing chest pain or any respiratory difficulties at any time please alert one of our staff.

Day Procedure Suite

Paediatric patients

Welcome.

We aim to make your visit to Calvary with your child as comfortable as possible.

One parent will be required to accompany the child throughout the admission and discharge process. We ask that siblings are not brought into the day Procedure Suite.

Once you have checked in at the Day Procedure Suite reception desk and completed a menu for your child's post-operative snack, they will be admitted as per the theatre list order. Please note that this may be different to the order of arrival. The nursing staff will endeavour to admit patients as quickly as possible and your patience is appreciated.

After saying goodbye to your child in the theatre suite, you are welcome to wait in our waiting room until the procedure is completed and your child has reached the last stage of recovery. If you choose to leave the Day Procedure Suite to move your car or get a coffee, please let the Day Procedure reception staff know, and please ensure that staff have your correct contact details.

Please ensure your phone is turned on and with you at all times as nursing staff will call you when your child is in the last stage of recovery. The staff will then collect you from the waiting room.
