As the effects of climate change become increasingly noticeable, protecting the environment and preserving our planet are among our greatest challenges. At Janitza, a company that offers energy measuring devices and solutions for optimized energy use, we feel a special responsibility. For many years, we have been actively committed to reducing our carbon footprint, taking into account all greenhouse gases in accordance with the Kyoto Protocol.

In 2021, Janitza set a goal to become carbon neutral by 2030. To achieve this, we calculated our corporate carbon footprint (CCF) with a cooperation partner, determining all greenhouse gas emissions across all three scopes in accordance with the Greenhouse Gas Protocol (GHG). During this process, we implemented initial reduction measures and offset all directly self-generated greenhouse gas emissions by supporting certified climate protection projects. As a result, we reached our first major milestone in 2023, earning the "Climate Partner Certified Company" certificate.





We are committed to continuously reducing our greenhouse gas emissions through ongoing implementation of reduction measures and annual balancing. The knowledge we've gained so far has enabled us to further specify our 2021 target.

"Our goal is to minimize our greenhouse gas emissions by 2030, primarily through efficiency and savings measures, and to supplement these efforts by promoting certified climate protection projects. For us, this is the Janitza way to make a positive contribution to climate protection." says managing director Alexander Veidt.

All steps are communicated clearly and transparently via the Janitza website and the ClimatePartner ID website. Currently, a carbon footprint at the product level (product carbon footprint) does not exist.
