Teams from universities around the world are required to conduct research on a publicly traded company, generate a written report and showcase their research findings to a panel of industry professionals. The competition takes place at local, regional, and global levels.

Kim Watile sits on the board of the CFA Society Norway who co-hosted the challenge together with Finansforeningen/CFA Society Denmark. Helge Nordahl was a jury member and assessed the written report produced by the teams.
