



Inside Calabash, Jumby Bay Island's Rarest Address

Luxuriate in nature at this uniquely warm, elegant, and modern beachfront estate. Where tropical tranquility meets understated style, Calabash stands as a private oasis — one of only two homes on Jumby Bay Beach — offering beachfront living amid lush verdant gardens and pristine white sands.



Jumby Bay Island, Antigua – September 2026 — There is a particular kind of loyalty that luxury cannot buy on its own — the kind that draws the same families back to the same Caribbean sanctuary, year after year, long after novelty has faded and the postcard views have become memory. On Jumby Bay, that loyalty belongs to Calabash Estate, which now holds one of the island's highest rates of repeat guests: homeowners and travelers who return not for what the island promises everyone, but for what only this one address delivers.

The story of Calabash is, at its heart, a story about the distance between hospitality and devotion. Every extraordinary estate on Jumby Bay arrives with its own dedicated household staff — that is the island's baseline. At Calabash, that baseline is where the experience begins, not where it ends.

Spread across 6,894 square feet, Calabash's five bedrooms — each with an en-suite bathroom and outdoor shower, sleeping up to two adults, plus an additional tub and powder room — accommodate up to ten adult guests within architecture that draws on barefoot island elegance: unhurried, unadorned, built to let the setting do the talking. It is space conceived not for scale but for attention — room enough for a dedicated team to anticipate every corner of a stay, rather than stretch thin across it.

A Team That Answers to One Address

The private chef, house manager and butler, housekeeper, and gardener at Calabash serve no rotation of properties and divide their attention with no one. Their craft belongs entirely to this one estate — from the pool to the shoreline to the fourteen-seat covered loggia where dinner unfolds each evening, a private stage for a single audience. That devotion finds its fullest expression in Chef Baggy, trained under Michelin-starred chefs, who turns the evening meal into performance rather than service: front-row culinary theatre staged in the loggia, Caribbean fare served against a backdrop that shifts from sunrise to sunset — a dimension of dining no conventional in-estate arrangement replicates.

"We've traveled extensively, but we've never experienced a vacation quite like this one," one loyal guest shared. "The service at Calabash is unlike anything we've encountered — the team seems to anticipate what you need before you even ask. Between Steve's cocktails on the beach and Chef Baggy's menu, which never repeats itself no matter how many times we've returned, every stay feels new. Simply put, it's the best vacation we've ever had."

A Setting Few Estates Can Claim

Calabash commands a secluded stretch of Jumby Bay's Main Beach, on the island's peaceful leeward side, where shallow waters invite swimming and snorkeling straight from the shore, and a walk along the sand leads on to watersports. Spectacular ocean views and legendary sunsets unfold from indoor and outdoor living spaces alike — and from a private sunset deck perched just above sea level — all framed by lush tropical gardens, a private beach section furnished with sunchairs and two shaded huts, and a 1,500-square-foot heated infinity pool with underwater massage, just beyond the terrace.
