Another significant addition this season is a sushi counter set on the panoramic terrace of the The Grill, available at both lunch and dinner. In a delicate culinary ballet, chefs elevate the freshness of the fish and the precision of Japanese technique, offering an immersive dining experience where the Mediterranean meets the Land of the Rising Sun.

Suspended between sky and sea, the dining experience unfolds as a spectacle.
